



Uniform Requirements

Marlborough Boys' College encourages pride in appearance. Wearing the regulation uniform is compulsory and a condition of enrolment. We appreciate your support to ensure that the uniform is worn correctly, and that boys of the College always conform to a standard of dress and grooming that will bring credit to themselves, and to the College.

The following school rules apply to appearance:

- **Correct** school uniform is to be worn, to, from and while in school.
- Hair is to be kept clean and tidy. Only natural colours are permitted.
- Students are to be clean-shaven.
- No visible jewellery, except one small ear stud may be worn.
- Students may wear a taonga around their necks underneath their shirts.
- School hats are not to be worn inside.
- Jackets are permitted inside at the teacher's discretion.
- MBC **sport** hoodies, jackets and uniform are **NOT** to be worn in school

The Marlborough Boys' College PTA Shop stocks the full uniform requirements (listed below) apart from footwear. This shop is located on the main school block on Stephenson Street opposite Carvell Street.

Compulsory Year 9, 10 and 11 uniform.

- MBC school shirt (sky blue)
- MBC school shorts (charcoal)
- MBC school trousers (charcoal)
- MBC school jersey (navy blue with gold trim)
- MBC socks (navy blue or grey with gold trim)

** A short-sleeved top/thermal may be worn underneath your shirt but must not be visible. If wearing a long sleeved thermal, you will be asked to remove it.*

Compulsory Year 12, and 13 uniform.

- MBC school polo (navy blue)
- MBC school dress shorts (tan)
- MBC school trousers (charcoal)
- MBC school jersey (navy blue with gold trim)
- MBC socks (navy blue)

** A short-sleeved top/thermal may be worn underneath your shirt but must not be visible. If wearing a long sleeved thermal, you will be asked to remove it.*

Year 12 & 13 students may choose to wear the full senior, full junior or the full formal uniform if they prefer.



Footwear

Students are required to wear the following footwear.

- Black sports shoes
- Black leather shoes
- Black Sandals with a backstrap (roman sandals) or Black "Birkenstock" style sandals.
- Sandals are to be worn without socks.

The following footwear **IS** acceptable

** Footwear must be appropriate to students' learning space (i.e. covered shoes in all science laboratories and practical technology areas)*

Formal Uniform

- MBC school blazer (navy blue)
- MBC school tie (navy blue with gold stripes)
- MBC school trousers (charcoal)

Outerwear

Students are permitted to wear the MBC navy blue softshell Jacket.

Plain black raincoats and plain black puffer jackets are also allowed but these are being phased out. Please talk to the uniform shop about purchasing outerwear should you need clarification.

Please note: From 2023 all year 9 students are only permitted to wear the MBC navy blue softshell jacket

- MBC school beanie (navy blue)
- MBC house cap (navy blue)
- MBC house bucket hat (navy blue)



Physical Education Uniform

The Physical Education uniform is compulsory for Years 9 - 11. It is to be purchased from the PTA shop at the College. Pupils are encouraged to wear sports shoes for inside and outdoor activities. For gymnasium use they must be clean and non-marking. On cold days Students may wear their college jersey and/or college jacket over the correct Physical Education uniform.
